The saints in the book are held up as an example to us that age is not a correlate to sainthood. Be able to demonstrate knowledge of why this is so in their individual stories.

The saints in the book had much help outside of their family in their faith formation. Be able to demonstrate knowledge of the various roles others played in the lives of the saints.

The saints in the book had a special relationship with God. Be able to demonstrate knowledge of what that relationship entailed.

Be able to demonstrate knowledge of the "additional materials" section of the book that addresses (1) death, (2) poverty of heart, (3) martyrdom, (4) euthanasia, (5) legitimate defense, (6) chastity, (7) catechesis, and (8) pornography - all within the context of the lives of the saints in the book and the challenges they faced. Know this section is based on the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

Note: We can distinguish between critical reading and critical thinking in the following way: (a) Critical reading is a technique for discovering information and ideas within a text, and (b) Critical thinking is a technique for evaluating information and ideas, for deciding what to accept and believe.

So, as you read "Ablaze: Stories of Daring Teenage Saints" please engage in (a) Critical reading, i.e. careful, active, reflective, analytic reading, and in (b) Critical thinking i.e. reflecting on the validity of what you have read in light of our prior knowledge and understanding of the world.
